5. Planning Applications

Cllr. BD advised that a planning application by Hall Farm, Dyson Lane had been granted, however the Parish Council had not received any formal notification - ALL to note

6. Financial Update

The most recent statements for the Current and Reserve Accounts were shared by Cllr BD Councillors agreed and approved the accounts.

7. Holmedale Nature Network

The Parish Council has an obligation to preserve and enhance biodiversity whenever possible. Anne and Edmund Baker, residents of Newsham and two trustees of the Holmedale Nature Network, (HNN) have agreed to discuss how HNN could support the PC in achieving biodiversity goals.

The planned meeting for Cllr's CB & SW to meet with AB/EB to develop a joint working plan was postponed due to illness and will be rearranged.

2) AB/EB have agreed to do work on the stumpery on the village green. This will entail planting insect friendly plants around and within the stumpery itself. The PC agreed to make £100 available to support this initiative.

3) The HNN have now been made aware of the conditions of use of the phone box

which will be used as an HNN information hub.

4) Cllr. SW has now registered for a Biodiversity training session in June.

8. Emergency Plan Publication

Cllr. SW proposed that the plan be circulated to affected parties for comment prior to publication on the PC website. This was agreed and will be circulated as soon as possible.

9. Village Green/Track

We still await pre-planning advice to clarify permitted works to the village green and adjoining track. work which can be carried out to the Green and adjoining track. Cllr. LT is pressing hard for an urgent response from the NYCC planning dept and will distribute to Councillors immediately it is received

10. VH Update

The Newsham Village Hall annual financial report was presented by Clare Alsop. Cllr. CB thanked Clare for attending, he also added his thanks to the wider VH Committee for their ongoing efforts.

The VH kitchen roof and adjoining stone wall with "Mistlethwaite" have both been repaired.

A quote for repairs to the VH guttering have been obtained and will be completed in due course.

A date for the major internal roof repair is still outstanding, an alternative contractor may need to be sourced.

11.Any Other Business

Cllr. BD advised that a new Insurance quote has been sourced but the current quotation price of £84 remains the lowest for the level of cover required.

The subsidy application for urban grass cutting on behalf of NYC has been submitted.
